Scheduled services: Monday to Friday, 6 a.m. to 5 p.m., and for all emergencies.

What makes the congregation special: "Services are completely nondenominational," Rodriguez said. "Our staff and patients is our flock."

Proudest moment: "Our 'Wholeness of Life Award' ceremony and dinner sponsored by the Health-Care Chaplaincy, which honors individuals who realize the importance of addressing the whole needs of patients: physical, emotional and spiritual," he said.

Most memorable wedding or other service: "A prayer service for Haiti immediately after the earthquake," he said.

Most dedicated volunteers: Ann Conners and Beth Mandalbaum.

Other services and programs offered: The Rev. Martin Luther King Memorial Service in January. Share the Harvest Festival service in November. A Good Friday Interfaith Service is held as well as special Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur services plus a Passover Seder. In addition, Catholic Masses are offered.
